

2020 YDSWG Secretary's Report

Membership currently stands at 269 which is up again from the previous year at 244. The numbers are different to the usual comparisons we make as due to covid we have not removed any members that did not renew and to the same token we have not added as many as usual due to not running courses. This is made up of 14 honorary, 19 life and 120 paid members and 116 existing members did not renew. We made a decision not to remove any members this year as activity has been affected by the pandemic. All members that have paid this year will be automatically renewed next year and all that didn't renew will get the option to renew in the spring of 2021
