*Terms and Conditions*

**Aim**

To preserve and to maintain the walls in the county of Yorkshire to a good standard and to conserve the landscape. All good principles of walling to be used – new foundations; through stones; no running joints; no mortar in walls; good filling and topping stones to match the landscape.

To recognise the skills of those who work to preserve these walls.

**Entry**

Entry is free.

Awards will be made for the entries which in the opinion of the judges merit recognition because the walling is to a high standard, blends well with the existing walls and uses the local style.

Either the owner of the wall or the craftsman who built it can enter the wall in the competition.

**Eligibility**

The scheme is open to all who live in the historic county of Yorkshire. Judges of the wall competition and their immediate family will be ineligible.

- ◆ *Walls to have been built in the previous two years.*
- ◆ *The wall to be in the historic county of Yorkshire.*
- ◆ *Walls to be a minimum length of 10m.*
- ◆ *Garden walls are **not** eligible.*

**Judging**

Judges will be appointed by CLA and YDSWG and will include a Master Waller.

Initial judging will be carried out from close examination of photographs. (It is therefore important that applicants submit good quality photographs specifically showing a view of the wall straight-on and the setting of the wall in the landscape. No people or equipment to be included.) The best ten walls to be viewed. Marks will be awarded for style, standard, features, landscape and a tidy site, taking into consideration impact and difficulty of terrain.

**How to enter**

The following information to be sent to the CLA North, 10 Aske Stables, Aske, Richmond, North Yorkshire, DL10 5HG:-

1. Completed entry form.
2. Maximum of five photographs – marked with the entrant's name on the reverse. (A stamped self-addressed envelope should be enclosed if the entrant would like the photographs returned.)
